**NEW** this year, applications will be accepted through online submission. Applications will be available the first week of January 2017.

While we'd like to accept all applicants, space is limited and we historically receive more applications than we have space to accept. At this time we estimate that there will be 15 to 20 spots available. The information you provide on the application helps us determine which applicants will most benefit from admission into the program. Please note that entry into grade 9 is limited to French Immersion.

Prior to submitting your application, please review the following checklist to ensure we are receiving **all required documentation**.

- Completed application form
  - Current official academic transcript
- Letter of support from your Provincial Sport Organization (preferably on letterhead)
  - o Art applicants letter should be from your provincial head or company director
- Athlete Assessment and Ranking to be completed online by your coach
  - This will be available online the first week of January 2017.
  - Art applicants please have coach/instructor complete to best of ability;
    coach/instructor can elaborate in letter
- Letter of support from your coach, including
  - Verification of Section E of your application
