The application process is online, no hard copies will be accepted.*

 - It is highly encourage that the student applicant complete the form him/herself, instead of a parent/guardian
 - There is a section on the form where the applicant's current official academic transcript can be uploaded
- Letter of support from your Provincial Sport Organization (preferably on letterhead)
 - Art applicants - letter should be from your provincial head or company director

- Athlete Assessment and Ranking - to be completed online by your coach
 - Will be available at <http://cscm.ca/whats-happening/sports-arts-program/> the first week of January 2018
 - Art applicants - please have your coach/instructor complete to the best of their ability
