A call for nominations will be sent out each year. Nominations will be due by Friday, September 16th 2016. The recipient will be notified of the selection and recognized for their accomplishment at the annual Cal Botterill Legacy lecture.

Selection Process

A committee including Mr. Jim Henderson, Dr. Adrienne Leslie-Toogood, Director of Sport Psychology at CSCM, Dr. Cal Botterill, the past award winner, and one ad hoc member will select the recipient of the Dedicated Service Award.

Recipient Information

The recipient will receive a small token of appreciation and their name will be engraved on a large plaque that will be on display in the CSCM resource library.

The recipient will also be asked to contribute an applied piece for distribution in the Sport Psychology Manitoba newsletter, and to be posted on the CSCM website. This information will also be forwarded to coaches and athletes via listserv and/or email. The development of this piece will be created in collaboration with the selection committee and is meant to provide applied information to the athletes and coaches in the province of Manitoba.
